



Respect Ambassadors

The League is implementing Respect Ambassador in order to improve the effectiveness of RESPECT policies.

- Every team must allocate a Respect Ambassador to every match.
- They must be clearly identified (bib/arm band).
- They will work with their opposite number and monitor their own supporters', team officials' and players' adherence to the RESPECT Codes of Conduct and, at their discretion, report any transgressions to their Team Manager, Club Secretary and/or League.
- In addition, Respect Ambassadors representing the 'home' team has the added responsibility on match-day of welcoming the Referee to the match and ensuring he/she is offered payment before kick off.
- RM will also provide marks for the Fairplay Awards scheme.



Fairplay Awards

- Marks will be entered onto FULLTIME system by the Respect Ambassador based on the questions below.
 - These marks will go towards a separate Award to honour truly sporting teams.
1. Whether Spectator Barriers/Areas were used.
 2. Whether a Respect Handshake took place.
 3. Marks for behaviour of players from the opposition.
 4. Marks for behaviour of supporters from the opposition.
 5. Marks for behaviour of coach/manager from the opposition.
 6. Marks for Overall behaviour at this match – Both Teams.
 7. Marks for Your team's overall enjoyment of this match.
